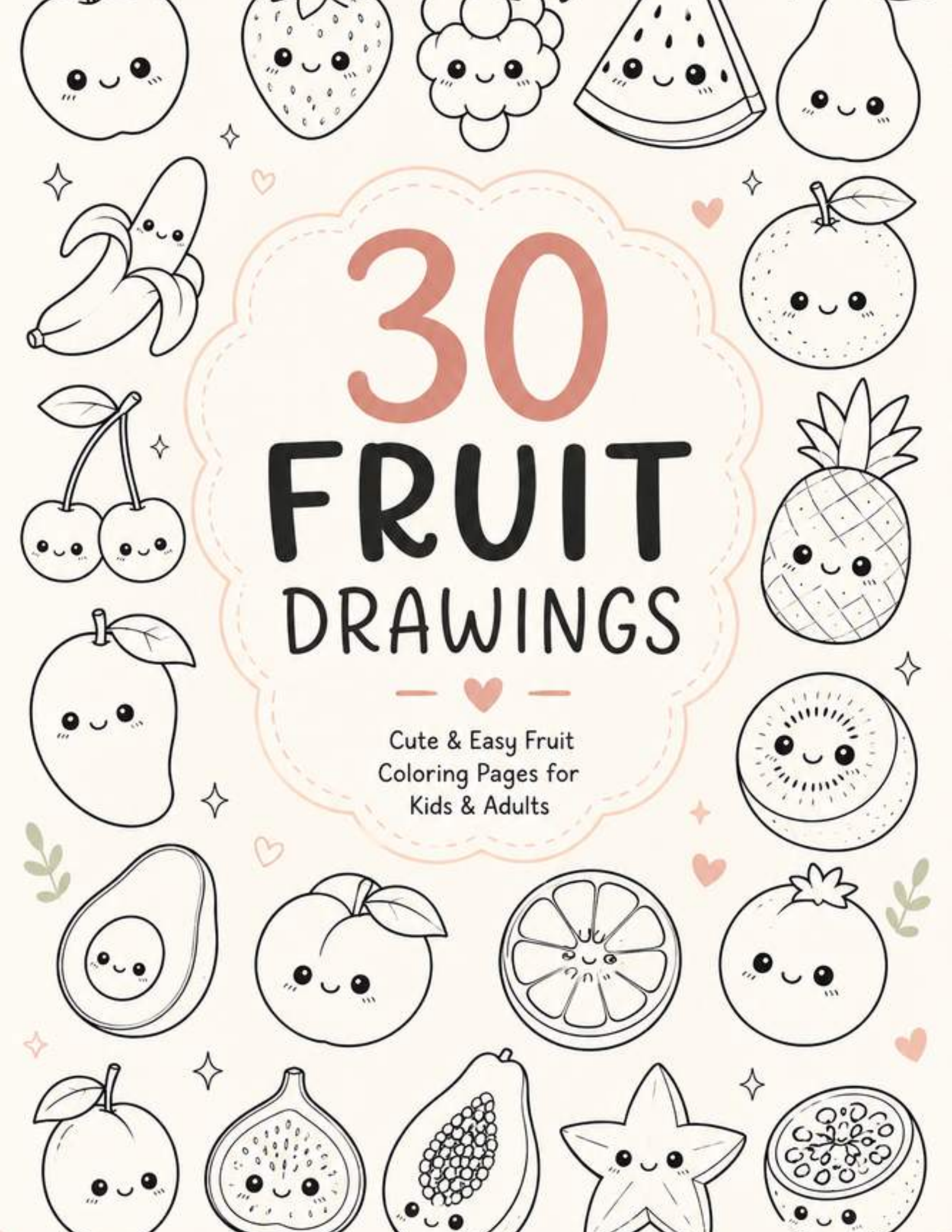

30 cute fruit coloring pages — and a simple way to draw your own.

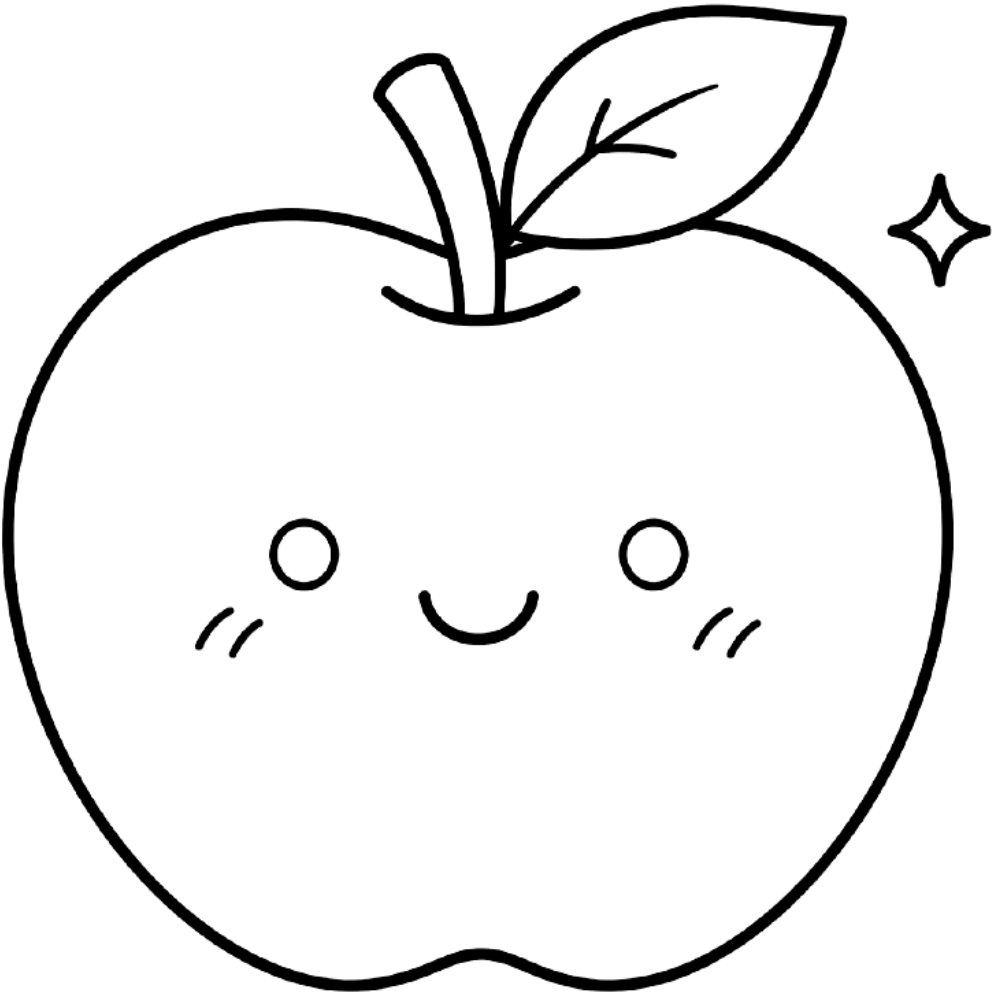
THE BUILD-A-FRUIT METHOD

- 1 **Base shape** Block in one simple shape — a circle, oval, or heart.
- 2 **One detail** Add a stem, a leaf, a crown, or a few seeds.
- 3 **A cute face** Two dot eyes, a small smile, and blush cheeks.

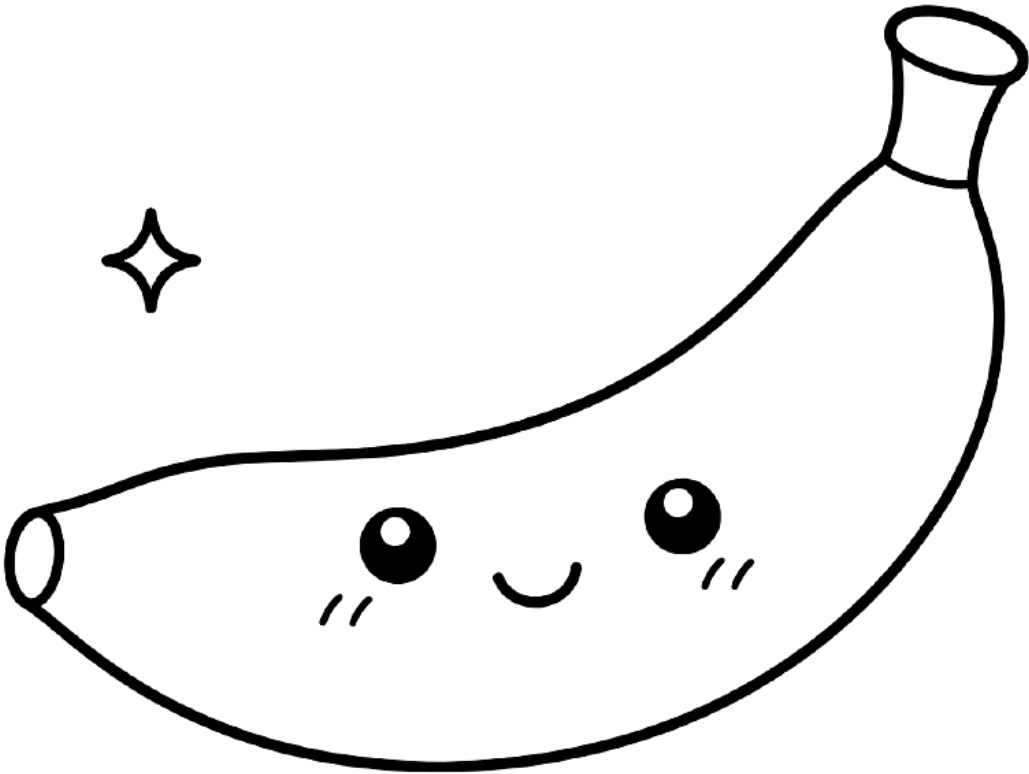
COLORING TIPS

- Print at 100% (“actual size”) on Letter or A4 paper.
- Colored pencils and crayons work best; markers may bleed through.
- Start light and build up color — soft, uneven shading looks charming.
- No wrong colors here: make a blue apple if you like!

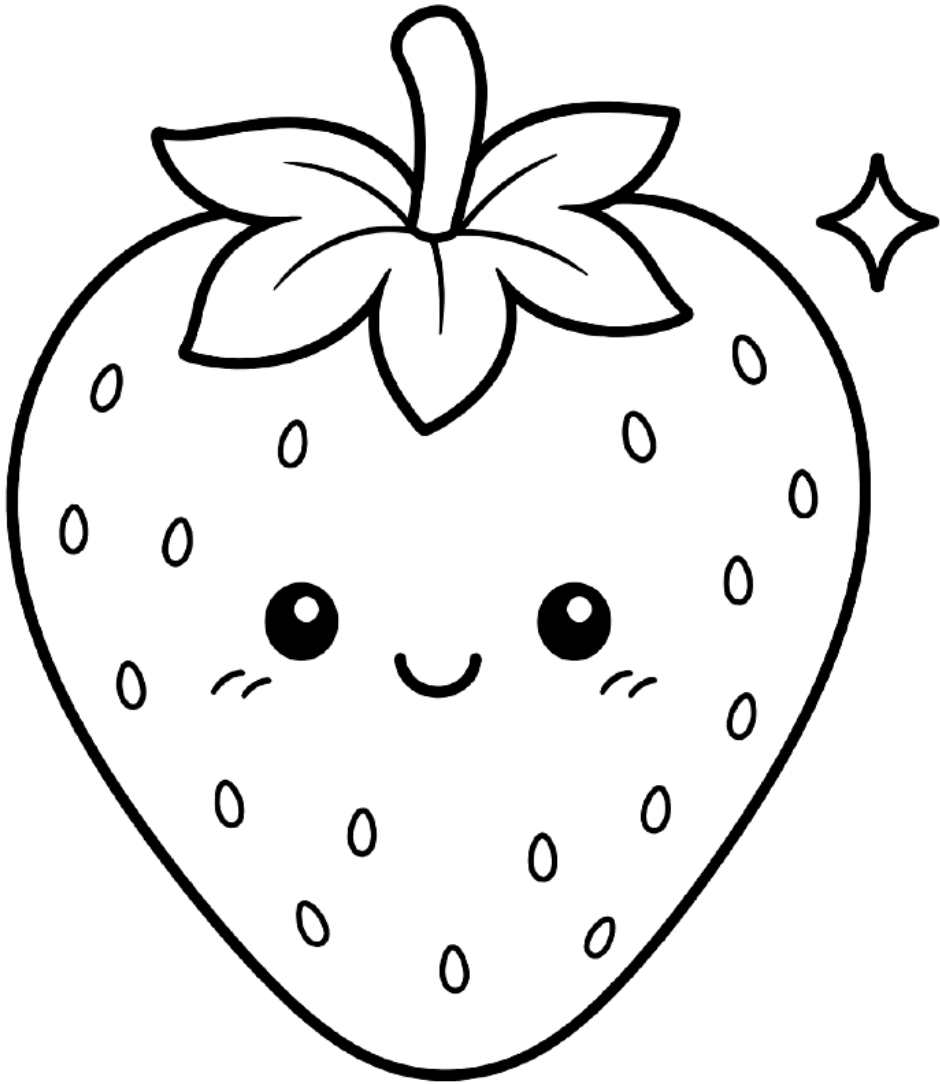




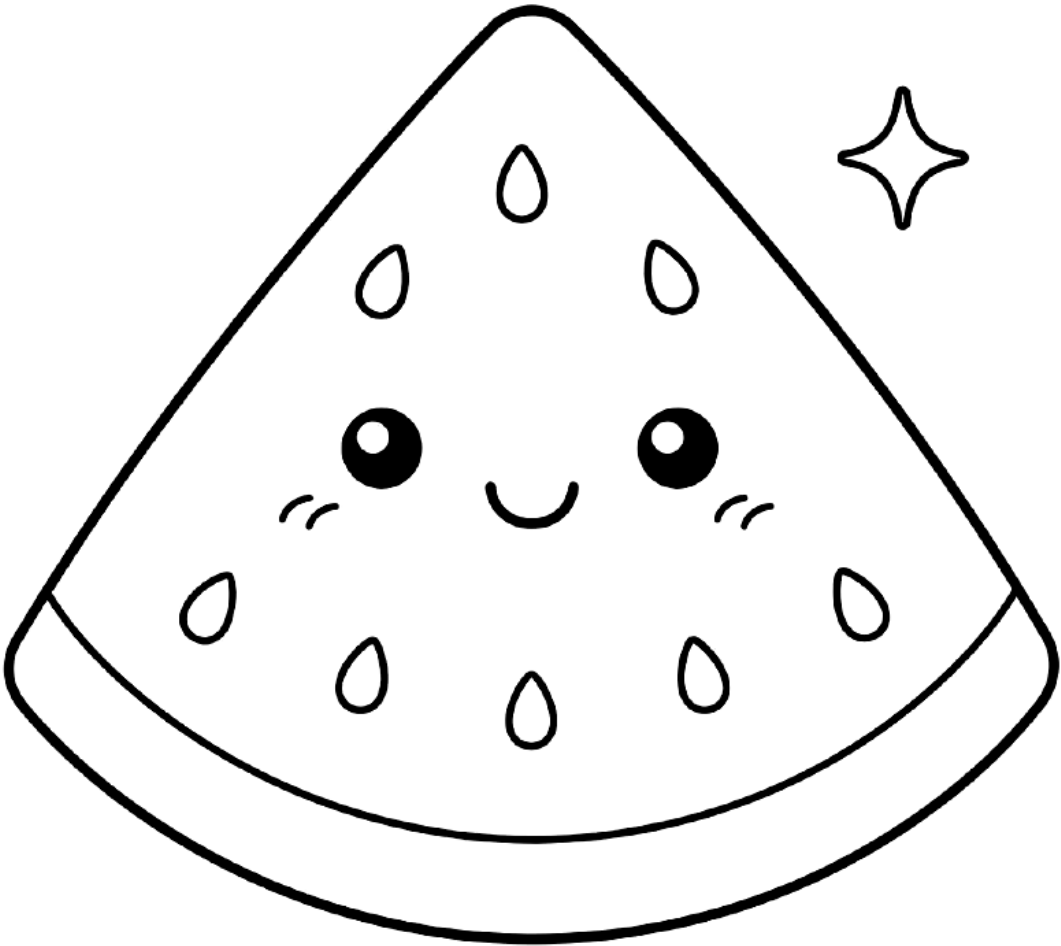
